## HOW DOES QUEEN CITY CLEAN WATERS BENEFIT ME?

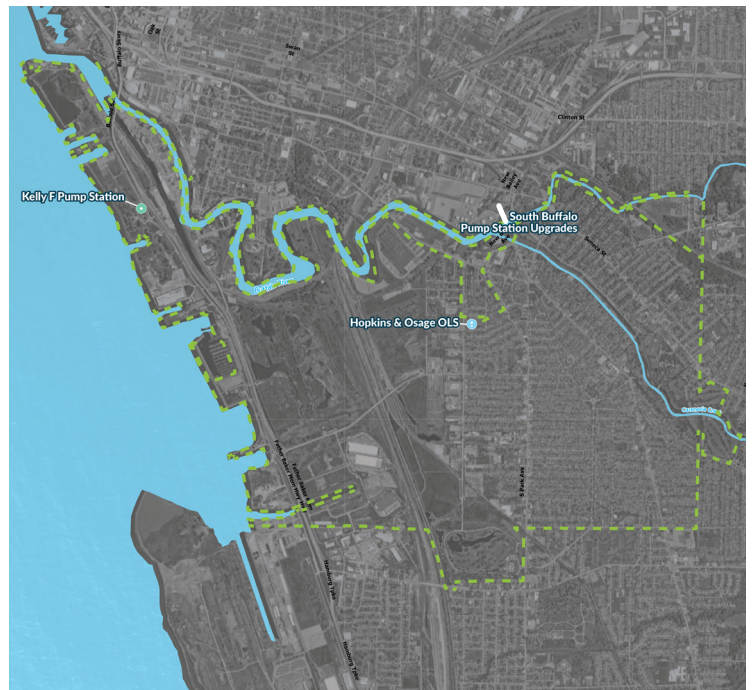
The projects will support the overall health of the community and protect our environment by:
