Overview of Recent Events

- Art reviewed the recent meetings with the Northland Taxpayers Association and the University District Block Club Coalition. These meetings were specific to projects occurring within their respective neighborhoods. These meetings allowed residents to ask questions and get acquainted with the projects.
- Walt shared his experience with the Northland Taxpayers Association meeting and how informative the meeting was in terms of getting questions from the residents that the engineering team had not heard yet.
- Nadia and Jaia shared their experience with the University District Block Club Coalition and how the residents asked for more visuals to be created to showcase the projects

happening in their neighborhoods. Nadia also shared the need to have more plain language when reviewing projects.

- Sandy Smith asked if there was a sense of community fatigue with all of the projects that are ongoing within their neighborhoods. Not just related to the QCCWI projects but also other projects that are ongoing throughout the city.
 - Walt answered that he did not feel that was the case, but rather people were more curious about upcoming projects. They asked about other projects and how this project may interact or affect them.
- Rosey shared that the Buffalo Sewer Team has also been attended the Envision Neighborhood meetings that are hosted by the City of Buffalo to share projects happening in individual neighborhoods all throughout the city.
- Dr. Cortasia Solomon-Carter shared that many block club coalitions/block clubs have members that are already very informed on projects happening in their neighborhoods. Members of the block clubs attend all different meetings, go to city hall, and speak with their representatives and bring information back to share with their neighbors.
- Rosey spoke about the Buffalo Sewer Authorities 90th Birthday Celebration/Groundbreaking ceremony. Stakeholders from the Queen City Clean Waters overall project, BSA board members, BSA employees, council representatives, the mayor, and stakeholders from the E. Delavan specific project came together to celebrate and bring attention to the work BSA is doing.
 - Darnell Haywood shared his experience with the groundbreaking ceremony, he was impressed by the amount of BSA employees that were in attendance to showcase the diversity of the employees.
- Art reviewed the first council district meeting held in the South District of Buffalo. The meeting was held at the Irish Center. A resident informed us that it was Holy Thursday and that they were there to take notes and take back information to the community because many people were at church and unable to attend.
