EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT FOR AGREEMENT WITH GREELEY AND HANSEN, A TYLIN COMPANY FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS PROGRAM MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS: The Buffalo Sewer Authority issued a request for proposals (RFP) for the

purposes of securing the services of a consulting firm to provide Capital Projects Program Management Services for an initial five (5) year guaranteed period with up to five (5) additional one-year extensions on July

11, 2023; and

WHEREAS: Four (4) firms responded to this RFP; and

WHEREAS: A consultant selection committee appointed by the General Manager

reviewed the submitted proposals and interviewed each team and ranked the

firms on the basis of both their interviews and proposals; and

WHEREAS: The RFP provided a contract value not to exceed \$6,000,000.00 (six million

dollars) with future year's contract values to be negotiated between the Authority and the Consultant on the basis of work anticipated and the wage

and fee structures provided in the Consultant's cost proposal; and

SETTLEMENT OF NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HUMAN RIGHTS COMPLAINT

WHEREAS: On April 17, 2023, Micah Lamarti (Complainant) filed a complaint with the New

York State Division of Human Rights charging the Buffalo Sewer Authority (BSA),

collectively (the Parties), with unlawful employment discrimination; and

WHEREAS: The New York State Division of Human Rights determined that it had jurisdiction

over the complaint and referred the parties for a public hearing; and

WHEREAS: Before the commencement of a public hearing, the parties reached a stipulation of

settlement; and

WHEREAS: By entering into the stipulation of settlement, the BSA does not admit to any

violation of the Human Rights Law or to any liability for the charges of the

complaint; and

WHEREAS: The BSA agrees to pay and the Complainant agrees to accept the amount of

\$1500.00 in complete settlement of the complaint. In accordance with federal law, this amount shall be reported on Internal Revenue Service form 1099. The parties agree that any and all tax liabilities on this amount will be the sole responsibility of

the Complainant; and

WHEREAS: The Complainant consents to the termination of the complaint before the New York

State Division of Human Rights and before the United States Equal Employment

Opportunity Commission.

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of the Buffalo Sewer Authority hereby authorizes the Executive

Secretary and Principal Sanitary Engineer to enter into the stipulation of settlement

and to pay to Complainant the amount of \$1,500.00.
