3. Project Updates – Breckenridge Street Combined Sewer Overflow Project

- This project will reduce CSOs in the Black Rock Canal and improve water quality.
- The overflows will go to the treatment plant instead of into our waterways, untreated.
- Outreach plan includes advance notice of construction impacts (Property owners and area residents)

- Construction completion by 2028
