**AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE CYBER INSURANCE**

WHEREAS: The Buffalo Sewer Authority currently receives cyber insurance coverage through Lloyd’s of London/CFC Underwriting; and

WHEREAS: Lloyd’s of London/CFC has proposed a renewal extension to the Authority’s cyber insurance coverage for the period July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, with a 10% increase at a cost not to exceed \$38,906.25; and

WHEREAS: The Authority’s insurance broker, Lawley Insurance, received proposals from Lloyd’s of London/CFC and Travelers Insurance. It was determined that Lloyd’s of London/CFC’s comparative pricing, terms, and conditions provide stronger coverage than the proposal from Travelers Insurance; and

WHEREAS: The Executive Secretary and the Systems Administrator have carefully reviewed the policies and recommend accepting the proposal from Lloyd’s of London/CFC; and
