



UPCOMING WORK IN THE FILLMORE COMMON COUNCIL DISTRICT

Buffalo Sewer, through its Queen City Clean Waters initiative, is addressing stormwater challenges across the city.

In **December 2025**, our team will be conducting site mapping and soil investigations in your neighborhood by drilling small holes in the ground to gather essential data for these projects.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Location:** Our crews, identifiable by yellow vests and hard hats, will be working in the following areas:
 - **Waterfront Park: between Carolina Street and Village Court, and between Trenton Road and 4th Street.**
 - **Along 4th Street and Trenton Road, west of the Waterfront Elementary School parking lot.**
- **Purpose:** To document site features and assess underground conditions for upcoming improvements.
- **Process:** Crews will map surface features using specialized equipment, and we will drill small holes to collect soil and rock samples for testing. Once drilling is complete, the area will be restored. Monitoring wells are needed; they will be installed flush with the surface and securely capped.
- **Impact:** You might notice some noise during work, but we will take precautions to minimize any inconvenience.
- **Precautions to Ensure Public Safety:** To ensure the public will not be exposed to potentially contaminated soil or groundwater during the drilling operations, the following precautions will be taken:
 - **Dust Control Measures:** Dust suppression techniques, such as water spraying, will be used to prevent the spread of potentially contaminated dust.
 - **Protective Barriers:** Physical barriers and fencing will be installed around the drilling site to restrict public access.
 - **Monitoring:** Continuous air monitoring will be conducted to detect any airborne contaminants. If detected, additional control measures will be implemented immediately.
 - **Containment:** Potentially contaminated soil and groundwater will be contained and handled in accordance with state and federal regulations. Excess soil cuttings will be secured in drums and transported to appropriate disposal facilities.
 - **Safety Protocols:** All personnel on-site will adhere to strict health and safety protocols, including wearing personal protective equipment.
